SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

- Student:
- 1) is a graduating senior from a Greater Valley Area high school or home school
 - 2) is seeking a college degree in the Fine Arts areas
 - 3) has the greatest financial need for scholarship
 - 4) establishes past and present participation in New Horizon Theatre productions, either on stage or crew
 - 5) will provide in the application, or attached on additional sheet, a brief paragraph describing how involvement with NHT has influenced your decision on choice of college and degree area

These criteria will be assigned points as follows:

- 1) 5 points
- 2) 10 points
- 3) Maximum of 10 points based on need
- 4) 20 points for each NHT production, either on stage or production crew
- 5) Paragraph will aid in the overall Board decision, no points assigned

Student or students with the highest number of points will be awarded funds for college expenses.

(If a Board member were a parent of a senior who is applying, that member will abstain from voting)
